Adverse Weather Conditions

As winter approaches please can we remind you about our general procedures regarding possible school closure in the event of severe weather:

- 1. Closure of the school will be posted on the school website www.coalway-inf.gloucs.sch.uk
- 2. If there is heavy snowfall overnight you will be contacted by ParentMail by 8.00 a.m. the next day informing you of closure of the school.
- 3. If you have not received a ParentMail message you may check by telephoning the school after 8.00 a.m. to check if the school is open.
- 4. Listen to Radio Gloucestershire FM 104.7 and/or Heart Gloucestershire (formerly Severn Sound) FM 102.4; AM 774. They will give news about school closures.
- 5. Access the Gloucestershire website to view the list of schools that are closed www.glosclosedschools.com
- 6. It may be necessary for the school to close during the course of the day. In that case, it is very important that we have an emergency contact number as a ParentMail message will be sent in the first instance.

Attendance

Thank you to all parents who telephone or email to let us know of their child's absence. This is a significant help to the staff and ensures that appropriate absence records are kept for your child. If your child is unwell and cannot attend school please could you inform the School Office as early as possible (preferably by 9.00 a.m.). As part of our attendance procedures Mrs. Edwards or Mrs. Cornes will contact you via telephone or ParentMail if we are unsure of a reason for absence.
